

## *Cat Ownership Stats*



Approximately 90 million owned cats live in the U.S.



Thirty-four percent of U.S. households (or 37.7 million) own at least one cat



Fifty percent of owners own more than one cat — On average, owners have two cats (2.4)



Slightly more owned cats are female than male (66 percent versus 64 percent respectively)



Fifteen percent of owned cats were adopted from an animal shelter



Eighty-four percent of owned cats are spayed or neutered
