Teach your dog to be a great companion and polite family member. In addition to learning basic commands, such as sit, come and stay, you will learn aspects of animal behavior to help you understand, prevent and correct problem behaviors.

Our dedicated volunteers have been training Central Ohio's dogs since 1994.

Basic Training for Puppies 12 weeks - 6 months
Basic Training for Dogs 6 months or older

Our basic training classes include:

- ✓ Learning come, sit, down, stay, leash skills, leave-it and more.
- ✓ Introduction to agility equipment.
- ✓ Practical handling skills designed to make vet and grooming visits less stressful and more enjoyable for your pet.
- ✓ Learn how to get your dog to focus around distractions including every day items that may startle dogs.
- ✓ Fun games designed to facilitate learning and practice.
- ✓ Basic classes are one hour a week for six consecutive weeks.

NEW: Intermediate level classes

Refine your dog's skills by taking it to the next level with our one-hour intermediate workshops. Emphasis is placed on increased reliability around distractions. Topics include leash work, heeling, stay, recall (come when called), leave-it and an introduction to clicker training techniques such as targeting and free-shaping. Prerequisite: an approved basic level course.
