Samples of her work can be seen in the Permanent Collection of the Smithsonian, the Thompson Museum in Kentucky, the National Guard Armory on St. Croix, Roosevelt Park on St. Thomas and Veterans Park on St. Croix. On St. Croix, her Lady of Justice, a life size bronze, marks the entrance to the United States Federal Court Building, a Federal Art-in-Architecture installation. For the past fifteen years she has designed and crafted ornaments for the National Christmas Tree of Peace.
